This evidence is then analyzed to help determine if the cause of the fire was accidental or deliberate. During the scene examination, investigators may find evidence such as accelerants, tampered utilities, and specific burn patterns, which may indicate criminal activity.

The first step in a fire investigation is the preliminary scene examination/size-up. Fire investigation, sometimes referred to as origin and cause investigation, is the analysis of fire-related incidents. After firefighters extinguish a fire, an investigation is launched to determine the origin and cause of the fire or explosion. Investigations of such incidents require a systematic approach and knowledge of basic fire science.

Arson investigation starts with the fire itself. To create and sustain a fire three factors must be present. The three factors are known as the fire triangle (Peige ed., 1977). The fire triangle consists of oxygen, a fuel source, and heat.

### Arson Investigation | Crime & Clues

Fire investigation can be performed in two stages. The first involves examination of the fire scene to determine the cause of the fire, its origin, and the development/spread of the fire. The second stage involves laboratory analysis of samples recovered from a fire scene, normally when arson is suspected 1.2 .
