They're "closer" to independent reading, so you're getting students ready to use these same strategies on their own.

### Read-Aloud, Shared Reading, Guided Reading: What's the ...

Before Reading Activities. As the teacher, you'll choose an appropriate text for the group. Make sure it's at a slightly higher level than what they can read on their own. They should need your help. This is guided reading, after all. In advance, prepare a teaching point, discussion questions, and (if desired) an extension such as word work or guided writing.
